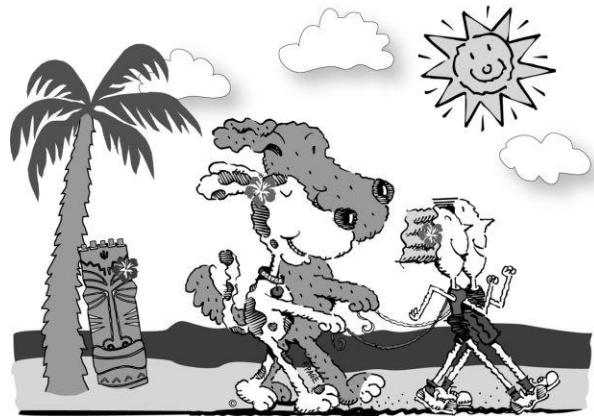

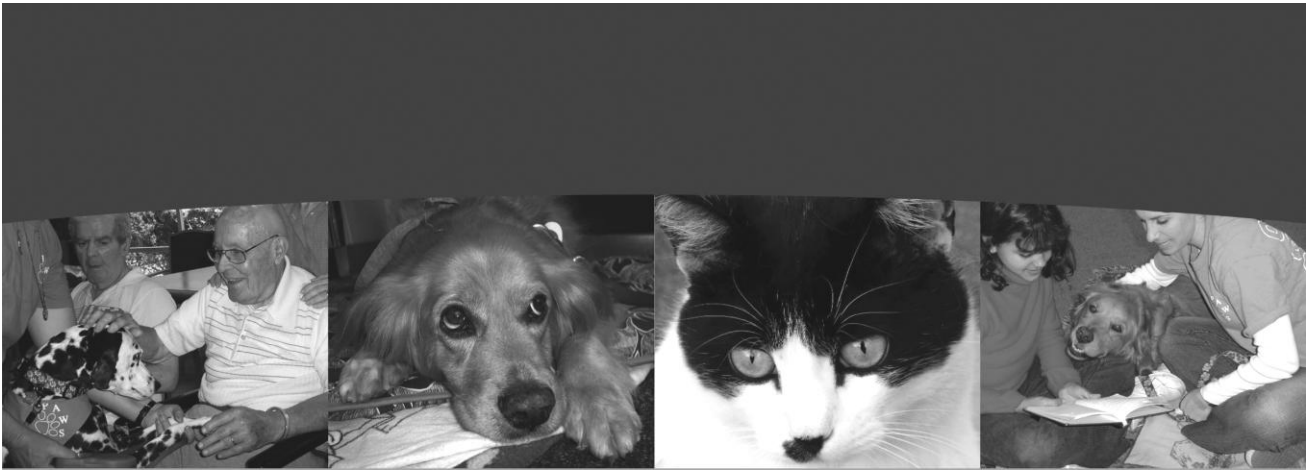

"NO EMPTY BOWLS" Tracy Roberts Food Bank Delivers Much Needed Help to Pets

"No Empty Bowls" is the OCSPCA's newest program that assists low income pet owners feed furry family members during times of need. The program began during the 2009 Thanksgiving season and was master-minded by two invaluable OCSPCA supporters, Lissa Gustafson and Mary Kinkella. Lissa and Mary are the owners of Animalia, a pet supply shop and boutique located at 16389 Bolsa Chica Street in Huntington Beach. Animalia generously donates store space to collect food for the program as well as making many food donations. One more drop off location has recently been added by the OCSPCA's friends at Doggietown USA located at 7466 Edinger Avenue in Huntington Beach. The program is in its infant stage but has helped more than 100 pets so far. The OCSPCA is finding that there are a lot of people out there that just need that extra little help to feed their animals for a short time period while they get back on their feet. Instead of a pet owner having to surrender their pet to a shelter because they are unable to feed their pet, the OCSPCA has been able to really make a difference in the life of a pet who would otherwise go hungry or be surrendered to a shelter. Food donations are greatly needed at all times. The OCSPCA asks that you donate an unopened can or bag of dog or cat food and drop it off at Animalia or Doggietown. One donor recently got very creative when they threw a birthday party for their dog. In lieu of gifts, the owner asked for food donations for the "No Empty Bowls" program.
